Subj: MOBILIZATION PLANS FOR CONVOY COMMODORES

Encl: (1) Composition of Convoy Commodore Staffs and Vice or Rear Commodore Staffs

1. Purpose. To issue guidance and to identify mobilization requirements for the selection, training, and assignment of convoy commodores. This instruction has been revised extensively and should be reviewed in its entirety.

2. Cancellation. OPNAVINST C1000.6H.

3. Information. The initial assignment of qualified officers for duty as Convoy Commodores or as Vice or Rear Commodores is as follows:

CINCLANTFLT	8
CINCPACFLT	8
CINCUSNAVEUR	4
COMUSNAVCENT	4

The composition of commodore staffs is shown in enclosure (1).

4. Action

a. Chief of Naval Personnel (Pers-912):

(1) Issue procedures for procurement and mobilization assignments of Convoy Commodores.

(2) Arrange for maintenance of up-to-date mobilization lists of retired officer qualified for duty as commodores.

(3) Arrange for annual submission of commodore mobilization listings to the Chief of Naval Operations (N3N/N5N) and the manpower claimants listed in paragraph 3.

(4) Arrange for attendance of selected convoy commodores at formal course of instruction at Fleet ASW Training Center, Atlantic, Norfolk, Virginia.

(1) Provide training for Commodores.
