Subj: National emergency readiness plan for the use of the radio spectrum

Ref: (a) NTIA Emergency Readiness Plan  
(b) IRAC Government Master File, Frequency Assignments to Government Radio Stations

1. Purpose. To establish provisions for the implementation within the Department of the Navy of the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) Emergency Readiness Plan for the Use of the Radio Spectrum.

2. Cancellation. OPNAVINST 2401.1D.

3. Discussion

a. References (a) and (b) are promulgated separately by NTIA to addressees of this instruction.

b. Reference (a), prepared by the Interdepartment Radio Advisory Committee (IRAC) in collaboration with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) Liaison Representative to the IRAC, provides for the continued operation of services vital to the national security, the satisfaction of emergency requirements for radio frequencies in the most expeditious manner, and the transition to or from peace, limited emergency, or war emergency with a minimum impact on established radio operations.

c. The IRAC is responsible for maintaining the Emergency Readiness Plan in a current status, collaborating with the FCC, and for the issuance of revisions to the technical details, as required.

d. Reference (b) sets forth all existing nationally approved radio frequency assignments to government radio stations.

5. Action. Within the scope of this instruction, the following provisions apply:

a. The stipulations set forth in Part I of reference (a) will be observed in implementation of the plan.

b. Reference (b) shall be consulted to ensure that war/emergency requirements are satisfied with a minimum of impact on established services.

c. To the maximum extent practicable, the use of frequencies from reference (a) will be coordinated with Army and Air Force commands which may be affected thereby.
