PROJECTED OPERATIONAL ENVIRONMENT FOR  
HARBOR DEFENSE COORDINATION COMPONENT

1. Perform assigned mission under wartime conditions ashore in CONUS, out CONUS and territorial ports and harbors over which the U.S. exercises defense control and such other areas of economic or military interest as directed by higher authority.
2. Provide support capability to the local area Defense Commander and/or CINCLANT/CINCPAC Operational Component Commander in the development, coordination, and execution of designated coastal/harbor defense plans.
3. Function as the Operational Command and Control Component for the local area defense commander in the implementation of specific contingency plans.
4. Provide tactical information and intelligence analysis within mission operational areas.
