Subj: SHIPBOARD INFORMATION, TRAINING AND ENTERTAINMENT (SITE)
LOGISTIC SUPPORT

1. Purpose. To provide guidance and procedures for logistic support and maintenance of Shipboard Information, Training and Entertainment (SITE) Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) systems.

2. Cancellation. OPNAVINST 5776.1B

3. Summary of Changes. Fleet Television Audio Maintenance Activities (FTAMA) have been redesignated Fleet Support Detachments (FSD). Navy Broadcasting Service Detachment T-ASA, Sacramento, California, has been redesignated Navy Broadcasting Service Detachment SACRAMENTO (NAVBCSTSVC DET SACRAMENTO).

4. Background. The Director, Navy Broadcasting Service (NAVBCSTSVC) (OP-007C) is designated by reference (a) as the Program Manager for the SITE CCTV program. Under the Chief of Naval Operations (OP-007), NAVBCSTSVC exercises supervision and policy control over the procurement, installation and logistic support of SITE systems. SITE employs a unique supply system, which serves SITE systems only, pursuant to references (a) through (c).

5. Discussion

a. Reference (c) tasked the U.S. Army with providing logistic support to Armed Forces Radio and Television (AFRT) outlets. This responsibility was subsequently delegated to Television-Audio Support Activity (T-ASA), Sacramento Army Depot (SAAD) Sacramento, CA. As AFRT outlets, SITE equipped ships or submarines (SUB-SITE) are required to obtain logistic support for their SITE CCTV systems through NAVBCSTSVC DET SACRAMENTO.

b. When a MINI-SITE, SITE, SUB-SITE, or SUPER-SITE system is installed in a ship or submarine, a current edition of the appropriate procedures manual, reference (d), (e), (f) or (g) is provided. In addition, reference (h), the Integrated Logistic Support Plan (ILSP), is provided to each SITE CCTV equipped ship or submarine.


c. NAVBCSTSVC established a Fleet Support Detachment program to provide installation services and intermediate level maintenance and training for Shipboard SITE Systems. The locations of Fleet Support Detachments are listed in references (d) through (g).

6. Action

a. Fleet Commanders in Chief shall monitor the material readiness condition of SITE CCTV systems and ensure that the procedures contained in references (d) through (h) are followed.

b. Commanding officers of ships equipped with SITE CCTV systems are responsible for implementing and complying with procedures outlined in references (d) through (h), as applicable.

c. NAVBCSTSVC Detachment SACRAMENTO is responsible for ensuring a copy of the appropriate reference (d), (e), (f) or (g) and a copy of reference (h) are provided to each ship or submarine as part of the SITE CCTV system during installation. In addition, NAVBCSTSVC Detachment SACRAMENTO is responsible for providing replacement/updated copies of the appropriate reference (d), (e), (f) or (g) to each ship or submarine having a SITE CCTV system installed and to each "Copy to" addressee of this instruction.
