Subj: DISESTABLISHMENT OF STRIKE WEAPONS AND TACTICS SCHOOL
ATLANTIC (SWATSLANT)

1. Purpose. To approve disestablishment of Strike Weapons and Tactics School Atlantic under the administrative chain of command of the Chief of Naval Operations per reference (a).

2. Background. Strike Fighter Weapons School, Atlantic (UIC 47084) and Strike Weapons and Tactics School, Atlantic (UIC 47157) have consolidated under the command name Strike Fighter Weapons School, Atlantic. Both UICs will remain active until 30 September 2002 at which time UIC 47157 will be disestablished.

3. Organizational Change. Disestablish Strike Weapons and Tactics School, Atlantic effective 30 September 2002. The following applies:

a. Mission. SWATSLANT provides formal tactical air-to-air, air-to-ground, and comprehensive weapons load training to over 400 personnel assigned to 12 F-14A/B/D squadrons. The centerpiece of SWATSLANT fleet support is the F-14 Strike Fighter Advanced Readiness Program (SFARP) which provides advanced unit level air-to-air and air-to-ground training, preparing squadrons for Air Wing weapons detachments and subsequent deployment.

Another primary mission is the administration of the Strike Fighter Weapons Training (SFWT) program, an in-service training program designed to develop a junior aircrew's tactical abilities through use of a formal syllabus. SWATSLANT works closely with the Naval Strike and Air Warfare Center (NSAWC) and the F/A-18 weapons schools, Strike Fighter Weapons School, Pacific (SFWSPAC) and Strike Fighter Weapons School, Atlantic (SFWSLANT). SWATSLANT is the central point of contact for all F-14 tactical issues pertaining to strike warfare and performs other functions and tasks as directed by higher authority.

4. Action. This is advance change 39-02 to enclosure (5) of reference (b). DNS-RMC2 will revise SNDL.
