Subj: DISESTABLISHMENT OF USNS STALWART (T-AGOS 1) MILITARY  
DEPARTMENT (MILDEPT) AND USNS INDOMITABLE (T-AGOS 7)

1. Purpose. To approve disestablishment of USNS STALWART (T-AGOS 1) Military Department and USNS INDOMITABLE (T-AGOS 7) MILITARY DEPARTMENT under the administrative chain of command of the Chief of Naval Operations per reference (a).

2. Background. For FY03, the Appropriation Act for the Department of Defense removed \$13 million dollars from the Department's counternarcotics request of \$17 million dollars for the T-AGOS program. The remaining funds were only enough to cover the cost of deactivation and contract termination of the two remaining T-AGOS ships; therefore, the Navy was directed to deactivate the two counternarcotics T-AGOS ships immediately. Military Sealift Command has been asked to seek alternative uses for the T-AGOS ships in order to mitigate deactivation costs. The military departments on the deactivating ships must be disestablished as part of the process.

3. Organizational Change. Disestablish USNS STALWART (T-AGOS 1) Military Department and USNS INDOMITABLE (T-AGOS 7) Military Department effective immediately.
