Subj: PERMANENT DUTY STATION CHANGE FOR MOBILE MINE ASSEMBLY  
UNIT FIFTEEN (MOMAU FIFTEEN)

1. Purpose. To approve relocation of Mobile Mine Assembly Unit FIFTEEN under the administrative chain of command of the Chief of Naval Operations per reference (a).
2. Background. Mobile Mine Assembly Unit FIFTEEN was originally planned to be located at Naval Station Ingleside in support of the newly established MCM center of excellence and ships homeported there. Due to a lack of space and the long lead time for MILCON, it was temporarily located at NAS Kingsville, over 80 miles away. Moving Mobile Mine Assembly Unit FIFTEEN to Naval Station Ingleside will significantly improve services to their primary customers by co-locating this activity with the mine warfare fleet they serve. Monetary savings will be realized through reduced transportation costs, currently estimated at \$30K yearly and permanent change of station, funding for sailors transferring from sea duty at Naval Station Ingleside to Mobile Mine Assembly Unit FIFTEEN at Ingleside, TX.
3. Organizational Change. Change Permanent Duty Station of Mobile Mine Assembly Unit FIFTEEN effective 1 February 2003.

Mobile Mine Assembly Unit FIFTEEN provides storage, maintenance, assembly, and mine warfare exercise support capabilities for Hunting Mines MK 25 and MK 36, Versatile Exercise Mine System (VEMS) MK 74, MK 75, and Mechanical Sweep ET MK 6. Additional duties include storage and issue of ordnance items related to the AN/SLQ-48 Mine Neutralization System, which is installed in the MCM and MHC Class Ships.
