TACTICS SCHOOL, PACIFIC (SWATSCOLPAC) TO CENTER OF
MARITIME DOMINANCE AND MODIFICATION OF MISSION

1. Purpose. To approve subject name and mission change of Sea-Based Weapons and Advanced Tactics School, Pacific (SWATSCOLPAC) under the administrative command of the Chief of Naval Operations per reference (a).
2. Background. The name change from Sea-Based Weapons and Advanced Tactics School, Pacific to Center of Maritime Dominance is meant to show the command's function as Naval Aviation's Center of Excellence for Maritime Dominance. The principal reason for this realignment is to increase training support for Atlantic and Pacific Fleet aviation commands responsible for USW/SUW mission areas and to conduct advanced Inter-Deployment training for Battle Group Air USW/SUW forces in coordinated operations. This command will focus on improvements in training and standardization throughout the USW/SUW community.
3. Organizational Change. Change title for SWATSCOLPAC effective immediately. The following applies:

To function as Naval Aviation's Center of Excellence for Maritime Dominance, align USW/SUW Post FRS tactical training, coordinate all issues related to integrated tactical employment and training for Atlantic and Pacific Fleet air forces in Maritime Operations in support of the Sea Combat Commander, and to coordinate USW/SUW TAC D&E community issues and provide executive level management and policy decision making for USW/SUW community issues.

c. Major Claimant. COMPACFLT

d. OPNAV Resource Sponsor. N78

e. Administrative Chain of Command. Present reporting relationship through COMNAVAIRPAC and COMPACFLT is unchanged. Commanding Officer will report for additional duty to Commander, Naval Strike and Air Warfare Center.
