Subj: CROSS CLAIMANCY TRANSFER AND CHANGE IN IMMEDIATE
SUPERIOR IN COMMAND (ISIC) OF CYCLONE CLASS PATROL
COASTAL (PC) SHIPS AND PATROL COASTAL MAINTENANCE
SUPPORT TEAMS (PCMSUPPTM)

1. Purpose. To approve cross claimancy transfer and change in ISIC for subject ships and units under the administrative chain of command of the Chief of Naval Operations per reference (a).
2. Background. The Department of Defense has directed Navy to transfer the Patrol Coastal class of ships from Commander, Naval Special Warfare Command, where they performed coastal patrol, interdiction and special operations roles, to the fleet commanders for use in anti-terrorism force protection (ATFP) of USN ships and other maritime homeland security (MHLS) roles. This action carries out that direction by moving the West Coast PCs and their supporting PC MSTs under COMPACFLT claimancy and command.
3. Organizational Change. Effective immediately the following ships and units are moved to COMPACFLT claimancy with mission modification and ISIC change as shown:
 - a. Mission for PCs. To provide ATFP of USN ships and other DON assets as well as other maritime entities in support of Maritime Homeland Security (MHLS).
 - b. Mission for PC MSTs. To provide ATFP of USN ships and other DON assets as well as other maritime entities in support of Maritime Homeland Security (MHLS).
 - c. Major Claimant. COMPACFLT

- d. OPNAV Resource Sponsor. N75
- e. Administrative Assignment. Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet to be exercised by:

4. Action.

a. This is advance change 14-03 to enclosure (4) of reference (b). DNS RMC2 will revise SNDL.

b. Pending further long term funding of the Patrol Coastal class of ships, PCs and PCMSUPPTMs will continue to be based at current NAVSPECWARCOM facilities at Naval Air Station North Island, San Diego, CA. Facilities funding will be provided from MFP-2 funds.

c. Commands, bureaus and offices concerned are directed to take appropriate action to execute redelegation.

5. Cancellation Contingency. This notice may be retained for reference purposes. The organization action will remain effective until changed by DNS.
