Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF FLEET ANTI-SUBMARINE WARFARE COMMAND
(FLTASWCOM), SAN DIEGO, CA

1. Purpose. To approve subject establishment of unit under the administrative command of the Chief of Naval Operations per reference (a).

2. Background. The Fleet Anti-Submarine Warfare Command will be the warfighting center of excellence for Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW) and will focus efforts across numerous resource sponsors, systems command, labs, and operational commands to ensure Navy-wide competency in the ASW mission area. FLTASWCOM will be commanded by a flag officer that will report to CFFC as an echelon III commander. COMPACFLT will function as CFFC's executive agent (EA). A detachment of FLTASWCOM will be established in Norfolk, VA by separate correspondence.

3. Organizational Change. Establish Fleet Anti-Submarine Warfare Command (FLTASWCOM) effective immediately. The following applies:
