Subj: DISESTABLISHMENT OF MOBILE SECURITY GROUP ONE (COMSG ONE) AND REALIGNMENT OF FUNCTIONS WITH NAVAL COASTAL WARFARE GROUP ONE (COMNCWGRU ONE)

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 3111.14V  
(b) SNDL (OPNAVNOTE 5400 of 18 Jun 2003)

1. Purpose. To approve disestablishment of Mobile Security Group ONE and integration of functions and personnel with Naval Coastal Warfare Group ONE under the administrative command of the Chief of Naval Operations per reference (a).

2. Background. Atlantic and Pacific Fleet Commanders have determined that integration of Naval Coastal Warfare and Mobile Security Force is required to optimize readiness, training and operational support to combatant commanders. This integration will enable the units to train and exercise in the same manner they will fight. This integrated NCW force will provide the full range of Navy expeditionary security force capabilities worldwide and across the full spectrum of contingency operations, surge requirements and operational plans.

3. Organizational Change. Make the following organization changes effective immediately:

b. Revised Mission. The revised mission of Naval Coastal Warfare Group ONE (NCWG 1) is to provide harbor approach defense and port security in support of national policy in both an expeditionary warfare capacity and in support of homeland defense, including force protection operations, amphibious warfare operations and maritime pre-positioning force and to provide strategic guidance, administrative and logistics support to various harbor defense command units, mobile inshore undersea warfare units, inshore boat units, mobile security units and mobile security detachments.

c. Major Claimant. COMPACFLT

d. OPNAV Resource Sponsor. N75

4. Administrative Assignment. Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet to be exercised by:
