1. Purpose. To publish the official address listings and chain of command for all Navy activities, and homeport/permanent duty station assignments for ships, squadrons and other units of the operating forces of the Navy.

2. Cancellation. OPNAVNOTE 5400 of 13 September 2002.

3. Background. The SNDL was discontinued as a printed document in 1994, but made available through various automated media. It has now been incorporated into the Navy directives system making it more available to personnel throughout the Navy via the directives website and quarterly CD-ROM issuance. The SNDL is available in various formats (Excel, Access, D/B, etc.) on the first CD-ROM of the Directives set.
