1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval to establish subject shore activity under the command and support of the Chief of Naval Operations (CNO) per reference (a).

2. Background. By direction of CNO, the Naval Education and Training Command has developed a new naval education and training architecture based on the establishment of learning centers. Each learning center is designed around a specific functional area or job family with all related education and training courses consolidated under its control, which will provide significant improvements in the development and delivery of education and training to the fleet.

3. Organizational Changes. Establish the Center for Anti-Terrorism and Navy Security Forces and its reporting chain of command. The following applies:
