Subj: DISESTABLISHMENT OF NAVAL STATION ROOSEVELT ROADS,
PUERTO RICO (NAVSTA ROOSEVELT ROADS PR)

(b) SNDL (OPNAVNOTE 5400 Series)

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval to disestablish subject shore activity under the command and support of the Chief of Naval Operations (CNO) per reference (a).

2. Background. In order to comply with Public Law 108-87, Navy is disestablishing subject naval station. All operational units are currently being relocated, support activities will all be disestablished and the mission of the installation will shift from being a fully functioning naval station to a limited mission support activity, staffed only to support transition and disposal of the Navy's Class 1 and Class 2 property at Roosevelt Roads.

3. Organizational Changes. Disestablish Naval Station Roosevelt Roads effective immediately. The following applies:

a. CNI will take appropriate action to disestablish subject shore activity.

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b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete the Plain Language Addresses (PLA) in the Central Directory Component effective immediately unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. c. DNS-33 will revise reference (b).
