1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval to disestablish and establish subject shore activities assigned to the Chief of Naval Operations for command per reference (a).

2. Background. This action is part of the CNO approved transformation of the Naval Facilities Engineering Command. The object of that transformation is to standardize business processes, reduce the number of field commands, eliminate duplication of effort, drive down costs, and reinforce accountability, while continuing to provide top quality engineering services to the Navy and Marine Corps. This action is part of a realignment that will continue into the summer of 2006 and is designed to better align NAVFAC operations with the Regional Command Structure being implemented by Commander Navy Installations (CNI) to handle Base Operating Support functions. CNI has endorsed this action.

3. Organizational Changes. Disestablish Navy Public Works Center Washington and Engineering Field Activity Chesapeake and establish Naval Facilities Engineering Command Washington effective 23 July 2004. The following applies:
