(NETC), NEWPORT, RI

1. Purpose. To approve name change for subject shore activity assigned to the Chief of Naval Operations for command per reference (a).
2. Background. As part of the realignment of the Naval education and training organization, Chief of Naval Education and Training (CNET) was recently disestablished and a new command, Naval Education and Training Command (NETC), was established. In order to avoid confusion with NETC Newport, RI, the name of the Newport command is changed to Officer Training Command (OTC), Newport, RI. The proposed name also more accurately reflects the current nature of training conducted by the activity.
3. Organizational Change. Revise name for Naval Education and Training Center, Newport, RI effective immediately. The following applies:
