Subj: DISESTABLISHMENT OF NAVAL TRANSPORTATION SUPPORT CENTER (NAVTRANS), NAVAL AMMUNITION LOGISTICS CENTER (NALC), AND NAVAL PETROLEUM OFFICE (NAVPETOFF), AND ESTABLISHMENT OF NAVAL OPERATIONAL LOGISTICS SUPPORT CENTER (NOLSC)

1. Purpose. To announce Secretary of the Navy approval for disestablishment of subject shore activities and establishment of new subject shore activity assigned to the Chief of Naval Operations for command, all per reference (a).

2. Background. The disestablishment of NAVTRANS, NALC and NAVPETOFF is undertaken as part of the Naval Supply Systems Command (NAVSUP) Transformation Initiative, designed to realign the claimancy to more effectively and efficiently deliver services to the Navy as a result of absorbing a 10 percent reduction in its funding. The missions and functions of NAVTRANS, NALC and NAVPETOFF will be consolidated into the single command, NOLSC, without detriment to the support provided the fleet. Establishment of NOLSC will be in Norfolk, VA to align the command with Fleet Forces Command and Joint Forces Command in order to maintain a close working relationship with both. The three functional components of NOLSC (transportation management, ammunition management and petroleum management) will continue to function from their current locations as divisions of the new command. Small civilian and military manpower reductions will be realized from the headquarters consolidation.

3. Organizational Change. Disestablish Naval Transportation Support Center, Naval Ammunition Logistics Center, and Naval Petroleum Office and establish Naval Operational Logistics Support Center, Norfolk, VA. The following applies:
