Subj: MODIFICATIONS TO THE OFFICER TRAINING COMMAND (OTC),  
NEWPORT, RI

1. Purpose. To approve mission and delegation of authority changes for subject shore activity assigned to the Chief of Naval Operations for command per reference (a).
2. Background. CNO approved modifications to the title and mission of the Naval Training Center (NTC), Great Lakes, to include the execution of officer accession training programs. The new title for the modified NTC is the Naval Service Training Command (NSTC). Since the vast majority of functions assigned to the Officer Training Command (OTC), Newport, relate to officer accession training, the activity is more properly aligned under the control of the NSTC. In addition, the OTC Newport mission is updated to reflect the current training performed at that command.
3. Organizational Changes. Revise mission statement and reporting chain of command for OTC Newport effective 30 June 2003. The following applies:
  - a. Mission. To prepare Sailors and Marines, through enduring professional and personal development, to lead as officers in the Fleet, and to perform such other functions and tasks as may be assigned by higher authority.
  - b. Chain of Command
    - 1 CHIEF OF NAVAL OPERATIONS
    - 2 COMMANDER, NAVAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING COMMAND,  
PENSACOLA, FL (00076)
    - 3 Commander, Naval Service Training Command, Great Lakes, IL (00210)
    - 4 Commanding Officer, Officer Training Command, Newport, RI (62661)

4. Action

a. NETC will take action, consistent with reference (b), to issue revised mission, functions and task directive for affected shore activity within 90 days. Distribution of these directives will include the Director, Navy Staff (Resource Management and Comptroller) (DNS-RMC2).

b. Director, Navy Staff (Resource Management and Comptroller) (DNS-RMC2) will revise reference (c).

5. Cancellation Contingency. This notice may be retained for reference purposes. The organization action will remain effective until changed by DNS.
