Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF OFFICER TRAINING COMMAND (OTC),
 PENSACOLA, FL

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval to establish subject shore activity under the command and support of the Chief of Naval Operations (CNO) per reference (a).

2. Background. By direction of CNO, Commander, Naval Education and Training Command (NETC) developed a new naval education and training architecture to include the placement of enlisted and officer accession training programs under the control of the Naval Service Training Command (NSTC). Assignment of these functions to NSTC necessitates the organizational realignment of the Officer Candidate School, Limited Duty Officer/Chief Warrant Officer School and Direct Commission Officer School currently assigned to the Naval Aviation Schools Command, Pensacola, FL. These schools represent a significant amount of training workload and their management requires the establishment of a separate shore activity reporting to NSTC.

3. Organizational Changes. Establish the Officer Training Command, Pensacola and its reporting chain of command. The following applies:

To develop civilians, enlisted and newly commissioned personnel morally, mentally and physically and imbue them with the highest ideals of honor, courage and commitment, in order to prepare graduates for service in the fleet as Naval Officers; and to perform such other functions and tasks as may be directed by higher authority.

a. NETC will take action, consistent with reference (b), to issue a mission, functions and task directive for affected shore activity within 90 days. Distribution of this directive will include CNO (N09B16).
